2 hours before launch.

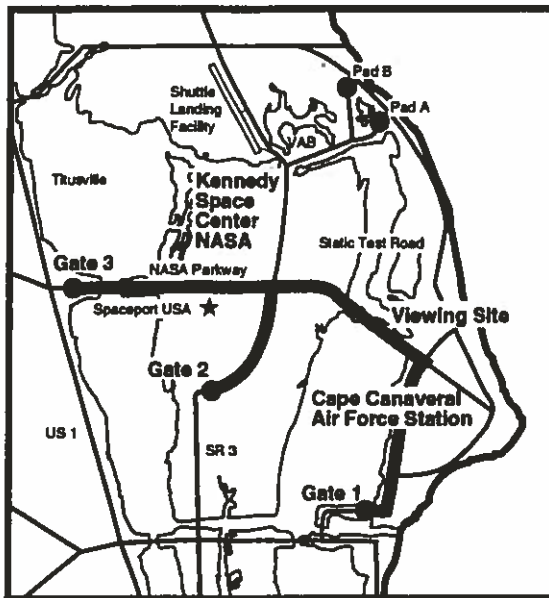

NASA Causeway Viewing Site

Any rocket launch involving a large volume of propellants and oxidizers creates hazardous conditions. If the situation requires emergency action, you are requested to respond promptly to instructions relayed to you via the public address system.

Display prominently in windshield with this side showing in vehicle.

Gates will be open 4 hours prior to launch. Gate 1 (south entrance to Cape Canaveral Air Force Station), Gate 2 (State Road #3, Merritt Island), and Gate 3 (US-1 and NASA Causeway). We suggest that you arrive at the access gate no later than 2 hours prior to the launch time. Gates will close for traffic 1 hour prior to launch.

Do not deviate from direct route to viewing site.

Following launch or postponement of launch, please stay in place until directed by security personnel. Guests may be required to exit different gates to facilitate traffic flow.
